Amish Country - Holmes County, Ohio

Wednesday, June 14, 2017

Depart 7:30 a.m. - Return by 5:30 p.m.

We start at the Amish and Mennonite Heritage Center in Millersburg, Ohio, where we pick up our tour guide, who will be with us throughout the day.

Depart from church parking lot at 7:30 a.m. on a 28 passenger shuttle bus

10:00 a.m. – Arrive at Amish and Mennonite Heritage Center – Enjoy a 30-minute guided tour and short film. This is a unique educational experience. You will see the cyclorama Behalt, a 10 foot by 265 foot circular mural illustrating the history of the Anabaptist movement, from its origins to the present day. German-born artist Heinz Gaugel began the painting in 1978 and finished it in 1992.

11:00 a.m. – Depart for back country roads touring

12:00 p.m. – Arrive at an Amish home for family-style lunch Enjoy a home-cooked meal and converse with “new” and old friends during your meal.

1:30 p.m. – Depart to Hershberger Bakery and Farmers Market Let your nose savor all of the luscious aromas of the baked goods. There are seasonal, homegrown vegetables, a huge assortment of flowers, a wide array of canned goods and many more things to see and buy.

2:30 p.m. – Depart for Heini's Cheese Chalet Heini's is the primary outlet for the Amish farms in the region. Sample over 70 different cheeses. Guests can enjoy the gift shop, fudge shop and retail store, as well as watch a cheese making video. Many of the recipes have traveled all the way from Switzerland by way of the Dauwalder family who still own the business today.
