Can I attend this event if I am not Catholic?

Where is my ticket?
With online registration, your ticket is immediately available. With mail-in registration, your ticket will be emailed to you. You can also collect your ticket at the registration desk on the day of the event.

Is my registration fee refundable?
Registration fees are not refundable; however, they are transferrable. You may change your ticket information at any time by clicking "manage ticket purchase" on your confirmation email.

Can I buy a ticket at the door?

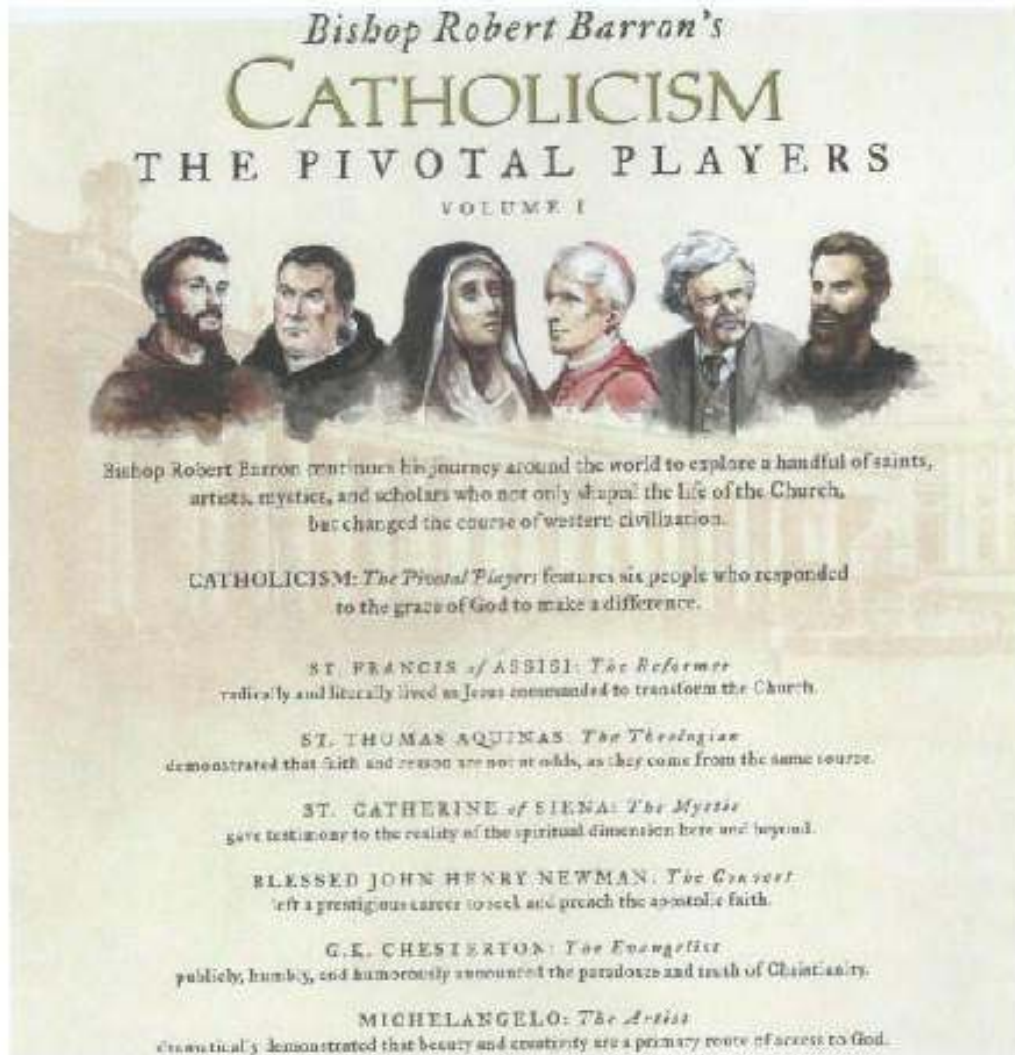
