RETREAT CENTERS

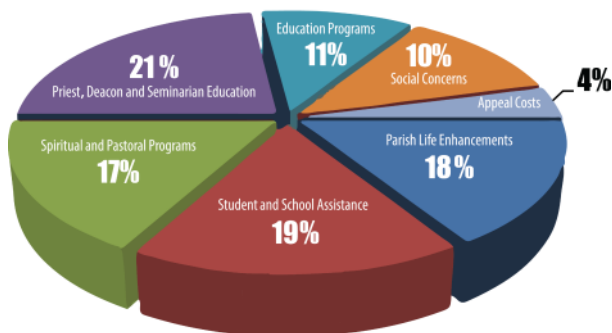
- Provides ongoing support for the operation and staffing of retreat facilities.
