Our **Confirmation Program is also a 2-YEAR** with preparation beginning in 7<sup>th</sup> Grade and Confirmation in 8<sup>th</sup> Grade. 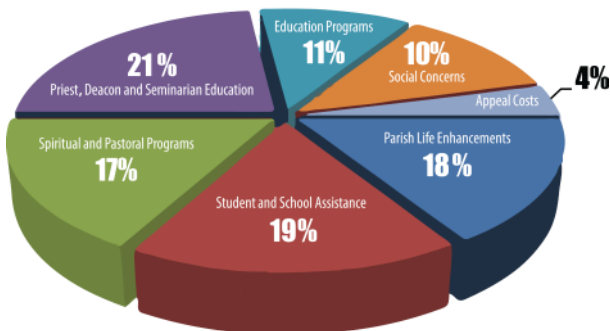

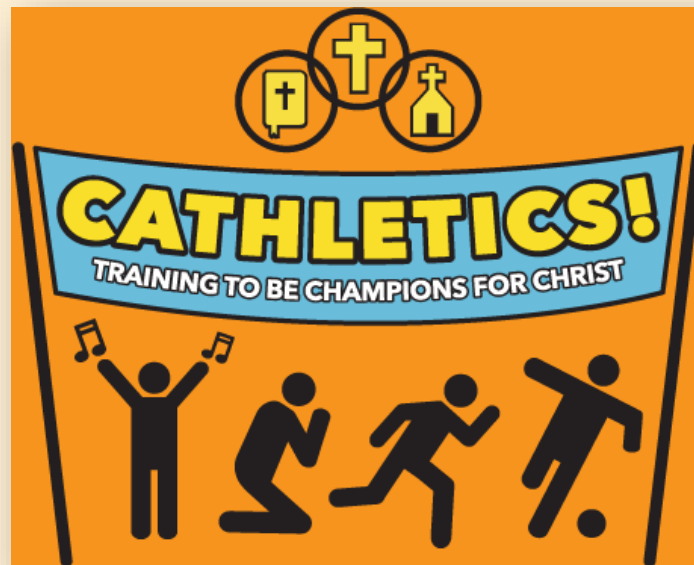
