**LIVING KIDNEY DONOR REQUEST**

Dear Friend:

I am looking for a very special person to be a living kidney donor as soon as possible! I am O positive and anyone in good health from ages 18-65 can be a donor. I was diagnosed with Chronic kidney disease of unknown cause in 2008 and have been on the transplant list for a deceased donor kidney for the past two years. I have been told that it could be another 2-3 years wait. The best option for a patient waiting for a kidney is to receive one from a living donor. Wait times for patients with living kidney donors are reduced from years to months, potentially avoiding dialysis. Transplant recipients have better outcomes with kidneys from living donors. Kidneys transplanted from living donors may last nearly twice as long as kidneys from deceased donors. Information regarding the donor process can be found by going to the Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center website <http://wexnermedicalcenter.osu.edu/kidneydonor> Ohio State's median wait time from donor approval to donation surgery is 2 months. Time is critical for me. There are no expenses for donors during this process. 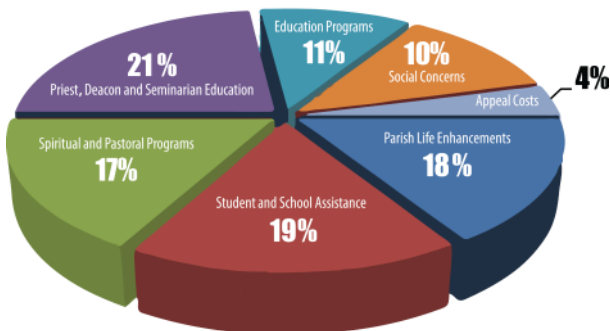

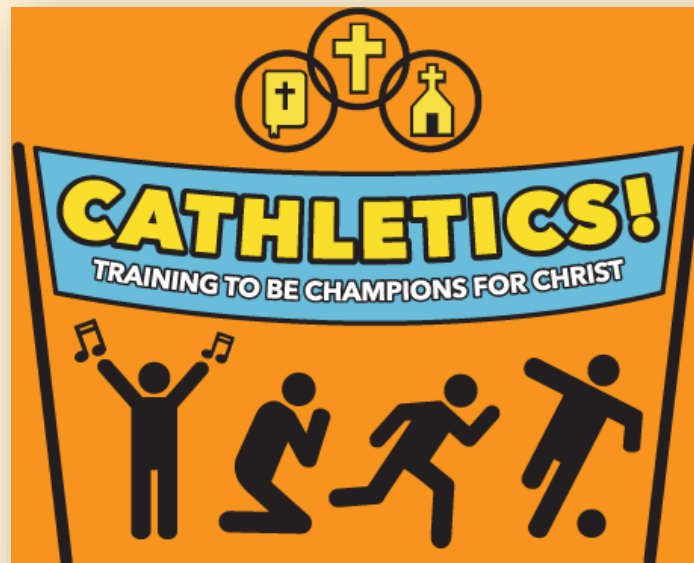
