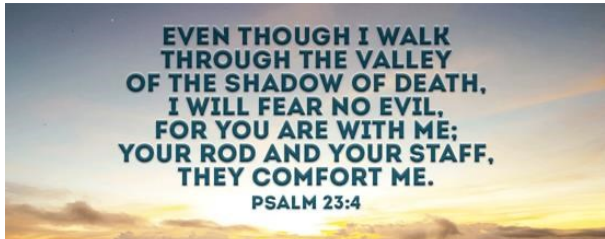

Our Lady of Victory continues to follow the Diocese of Columbus commitment to the protection and safety of children and the **SAFE ENVIRONMENT PROGRAM**. The Safe Environment Program states that all Volunteers 18 year or older who would like to participate in parish programs or ministries who have been delegated care, custody or control of children must complete two steps: 1) Attend a *Protecting God's Children Session* (one time only); and 2) *Complete BCI Fingerprinting*. The current schedule for attending a PGC Session is always posted on the VIRTUS website. Go to: www.virtus.org. Click on the Yellow Registration button just beneath the login and follow steps to register. BCI Fingerprinting can be done at FastFingerprints on Bethel Road. History of the St. Michael Prayer

Though various accounts of the origins of the St. Michael Prayer exist, one thing is certain: Pope Leo XIII was observed staring at something invisible or unknown while celebrating Mass. Immediately after, he went into his private office and wrote the St. Michael Prayer.* His private secretary, Rinaldo Angeli, claims Pope Leo XIII received a vision in which he saw Satan tell God that he would destroy the Church over time.

This was enough to shake Pope Leo XIII into action, as the prayer was mandated as part of every Low Mass celebrated between 1886 to 1964. Only recently has the St. Michael Prayer been reinstated into many Masses throughout the world. It's interesting to note that the older version of the St. Michael Prayer was much longer and widely used in the *Roman Ritual* by exorcists. The commonly known prayer is known by many faithful Catholics and is approved to be recited by the laity.

*** St. Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle! Be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil. May God rebuke him, we humbly pray, and do thou, O Prince of the heavenly host, by the power of God, thrust into Hell Satan and all the other evil spirits who roam about the world seeking the ruin of souls.**
